
Lyndhurst Mansion in Tarrytown Thursday, October 24th 2019

This time we make a trip into the closer environment. We will visit the beautiful neo-Gothic Lyndhurst mansion in Tarrytown on the banks of the Hudson River. The house was built in 1838 by Alexander Jackson Davis and was the residence of the former mayor William Paulding Jr.

The house is located in a 27 hectare parc, which was laid out by Ferdinand Mangold in the style of an English landscape garden. We will take a private guided tour of about one hour to see the unusual interior of this mansion. Afterwards we will have the opportunity to have lunch together in the surrounding area.
