

**UNITED NATIONS TOUR**  
**Wednesday, January 29<sup>th</sup>, 2020**



Discover the corridors of international diplomacy: on our next tour we'll learn more about the history and structure of the U.N. organization. Fronting the East River, the 18-acres parcel of land of the United Nations is considered 'international territory' that belongs to all members of the U.N. and is, therefore, technically not part of the United States. Our one hour-long guided tour will start in the General Assembly building and afford a behind-the-scenes glimpse of the organization, including a visit to the General Assembly Hall, with seating capacity of more than 1,800

people. The tour will also take you in the Security Council Chamber, as well as the Trusteeship Council Chamber and the Economic and Social Council Chamber.

Before the U.N. Tour, we'll have the chance to start the day in the German House with getting an introduction of the General Consulate of Germany. And after the tour, we'll get lunch together at the restaurant of the Consulate (eat and drink on a self-payment basis).



***IMPORTANT: We must provide a named list of all participants to the General Consulate 10 days prior to our visit. To enter the U.N. building, every participant required a valid GOUVERNEMENT- ISSUED -PHOTO IDENTIFICATION, issued by a Member State or an Observer State of the United Nations!***

**Meeting point:** 09 am at the German House (871 United Nations Plaza, NY 10017)

***Consider arriving on time to get through the security checking at the entrance***

Further details concerning meeting points at Metro North White Plains and Grand Central will be announced shortly before the tour.

**Cost:** \$25 per person, ADULTS ONLY TOUR
