

# SCHOOL REGULATIONS - School Year 2021-2022

## 1. ADMISSION:

Prior to admission parents are required to meet with the head of the German Language School. Students (age depending) will have to take a placement test.

## Classes are offered:

Wednesdays: 4:15 P.M. - 6:30 P.M.

and / or

Saturdays: 9:30 A.M. - 12:00 P.M.

Adult Class - Wednesdays: 4:30 P.M. - 6:30 P.M.

Please note that the final grade level for each school year will be assigned by the Head of the Language School.

## 2. COST OF LANGUAGE COURSES:

Registration Fee for new students: \$150.00

2021/2022 German Language School Tuition: \$1,500.00

2021/2022 German Language School Tuition Adult Class: \$1,425.00

Second Child Discount: \$50.00

Third Child and more Discount: \$100.00

#### 3. PAYMENT:

<u>A \$300.00 non-refundable tuition deposit</u> (for all students) is due when registering the Smart Tuition account.

Full payment is due by <u>August 15, 2021</u>. After that date a late fee of 1.5% per month (annual rate of 18%) will be added. In the event that tuition is not paid when due, the German Language School at German International School New York reserves the right to prohibit a student's participation in any academic or school activity.



All German Language School registration and tuition payments should be remitted through SmartTuition.

## **4. WITHDRAWAL POLICY:**

Requests for refunds must be made in writing to the <u>German Language School at German International School New York.</u> Registration fee and tuition deposit are not refundable on any withdrawal.

Our withdrawal policy provides for refunds as follows:

100% 75 % 50 % There will be no refund after the third class.

Allow 6-8 weeks for refunds. Your registration acknowledges the school's refund policy. (Please note: Failure to attend class does not constitute an official "DROP".)

## 5. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF REGISTRATION

You will be notified only if a class is canceled.

## 7. REPORT CARDS

## 13. Early DROP-OFF FEE and LATE FEE

An <u>EARLY DROP OFF FEE</u> and a <u>LATE FEE</u> of \$1.00 (per child) is charged for each minute to parents/guardians who drop off their child/children and leave before 4:15 PM on WEDNESDAYS, and 9:30 AM on SATURDAYS. Parents/Guardians who fail to pick up their child/children after 6:40 PM on Wednesdays and 12.10 PM on Saturdays will be charged a LATE FEE (\$1.00 a minute) as well.
